ITINERARY

Day-by-day itinerary

Your day-by-day plan. Everything is customizable — add nights, swap activities, or change hotels.

DAY 1 Kathmandu to Sauraha, Chitwan Private drive from Kathmandu to Sauraha on the edge of Chitwan National Park (~5-6 hours) with a lunch stop en route. Check in and freshen up, relax by the Rapti river for sunset, and in the evening enjoy the lively Tharu stick-dance cultural show. Travel time: ~5-6 hours by road Distance: ~155 km Meals: Lunch Overnight: Sauraha, Chitwan
DAY 2 Full day of jungle activities Early morning dugout canoe ride on the Rapti river to spot crocodiles and birdlife, followed by a guided jungle walk with a naturalist. After lunch, an open jeep safari deep inside Chitwan National Park in search of one-horned rhino, deer and wild boar. In the evening, an optional visit to the elephant breeding centre if time allows. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch Activities: Canoe, jungle walk, jeep safari Overnight: Sauraha, Chitwan
DAY 3 Sauraha to Kathmandu via Bis Hazari Tal After breakfast, check out and begin the drive back to Kathmandu. On the way, stop at Bis Hazari Tal (Beeshazari Lake), a Ramsar-listed wetland and birdwatching haven on the edge of the park. Continue to Kathmandu, where the tour ends. Travel time: ~5-6 hours by road Meals: Breakfast Activity: Bis Hazari Tal (Beeshazari Lake)
