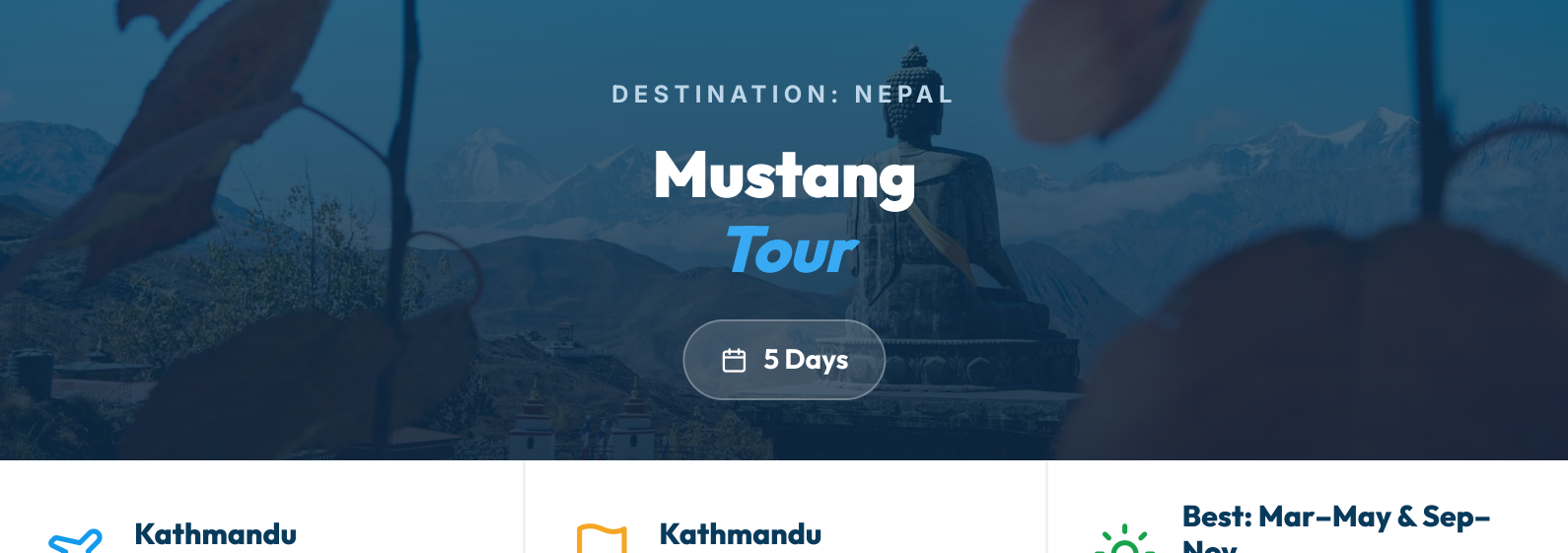

- ★ Darshan at the sacred Muktinath Temple (3,800 m), holy to Hindus and Buddhists alike
- ★ Windswept Kagbeni, the medieval gateway to Upper Mustang
- ★ Apple orchards, brandy and Thakali kitchens in Marpha
- ★ Sunrise over the Annapurnas from Pokhara's Lakeside
- ★ High-desert landscapes and Nilgiri views around Jomsom

ITINERARY

Day-by-day itinerary

Your day-by-day plan. Everything is customizable — add nights, swap activities, or change hotels.

DAY 1

Kathmandu to Pokhara

Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara along the Prithvi Highway (~6-7 hours) with a lunch stop. Check in at lakeside and enjoy leisure time exploring Pokhara. Travel time: ~6-7 hours by road Distance: ~200 km Meals: Lunch Overnight: Pokhara, Lakeside

DAY 2

Pokhara to Jomsom (Mustang), explore Marpha

Drive by private 4WD from Pokhara up the Kali Gandaki gorge to Jomsom, the gateway to Mustang. On the way, explore Marpha, the whitewashed Thakali village famous for its apple orchards and brandy. Travel time: full day by 4WD Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner Overnight: Jomsom / Marpha Accommodation: Lodge

DAY 3

Roaming Mustang - Muktinath, Kagbeni & Dumba Lake

Early morning drive to the sacred Muktinath Temple for darshan, one of the holiest sites for Hindus and Buddhists alike. Visit the medieval village of Kagbeni and the turquoise Dumba Lake, then enjoy leisure time back in Jomsom. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner Activities: Muktinath, Kagbeni, Dumba Lake Overnight: Jomsom Accommodation: Lodge

DAY 4

Back to Pokhara - Tatopani & Baglung Kalika

Drive back down the gorge to Pokhara. Stop to soak at the Tatopani natural hot springs and visit the Baglung Kalika temple on the way. Evening free at lakeside. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch Activities: Tatopani hot spring, Baglung Kalika temple Overnight: Pokhara, Lakeside

DAY 5

Pokhara to Kathmandu

After breakfast, drive back to Kathmandu with a lunch stop en route. Drop-off in Kathmandu, where the tour ends. Travel time: ~6-7 hours by road Meals: Breakfast, Lunch
